Student Pass Application

Requirement To Apply For Student Pass

Section 10 of the Immigration Regulations 1963 requires all international students (including the mobility students) who wish to study at any higher education institutions in Malaysia to obtain Student Pass before entering Malaysia. Students are required to submit application for Student Pass at the Education Malaysia Global Service (EMGS*) online system at https://visa.educationmalaysia.gov.my/customer/account/create/

Students are advised to **take note of the following** during the visa application:

- 1. Students must be residing outside of Malaysia at the time of their application.
- 2. If the student is residing in Malaysia, please visit the UM Visa Counter for further arrangement on the visa application. The visa application should be done by the University.



Please make sure your passport has a validity period of more than

18 months if you have been accepted the offer letter, please ensure you are using the same passport when travelling to Malaysia.

It is important for you to inform us should the passport number is different from the one written on the offer letter.

Students who submitted photo that does not meet the EMGS Photo Requirements will encounter delay in the application review processing and further dragging the visa approval process.










(International students with approved Visa Approval Letter (eVAL) have to obtain the Single-Entry Visa from Malaysian Embassy/ Consulate/ High Commission or Representative Offices before entering Malaysia. However, not all countries' citizens require a visa to travel to Malaysia)

If you are a citizen of a country that requires a Single-Entry Visa to travel to Malaysia, please select the nearest Malaysian Embassy from where you can obtain the Single-Entry Visa once you printed the Visa Approval Letter (eVAL) through EMGS website.

Please click <u>here</u> for the list of countries that requires visa to enter Malaysia.

Note: if you require a visa to travel to Malaysia but you are not in your home country, you can select the nearest Malaysian Embassy/Consulate/ High Commission or Representative Offices to you from where you can obtain the Single-Entry Visa once you printed the Visa Approval Letter (eVAL) through EMGS website.







Students who are attending any study programme at **Universiti Malaya** must only enter Malaysia Border through the **Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA Terminal 1 or 2)**

Please note that entering through other port of entry will be denied for entering Malaysia as the only allowed entry port for institutions located in Kuala Lumpur is **KLIA**.





New international students are required to perform a medical screening in Malaysia within 7 days from the date of arrival in Malaysia.

Please note that if the student is diagnosed with a medical condition that is deemed unsuitable for studies in Malaysia when undergoing the compulsory Post-Arrival Medical Screening, they will be required to bear the cost of leaving Malaysia. The students are also required to exit Malaysia before the expiration of their current pass.





Prepare a scanned copy of your Passport Data Page in PDF format.

For students originating from Libya, Iran, Iraq, Somalia, Sudan, Syria and Yemen are required to submit a copy of ALL pages of passport to EMGS.

As for rest of the countries, upload scanned copy of the Passport Information page, the Observation Page (If it shows any extensions, clarifications of name, and previous passport numbers), and any pages which contain visa information.

Please ensure that all required pages are scanned and uploaded as ONE PDF file.




How to track your application status?

Once EMGS received a complete Student Pass application from you, the Universiti Malaya will be notified and is required to verify your student status.



Once your application has been approved by EMGS (Application status reaches 32% - 35%), EMGS will issue an EMGS Approval Letter for you to download. And this also means that the application is ready for submission to Malaysian Immigration Department for eVAL approval.



What is EMGS Approval Letter?

The EMGS Approval Letter is an assurance that EMGS has vetted the application and the student has met the minimum academic requirements needed to pursue their intended course.



Once your application is approved by the Immigration Department of Malaysia, you are required to download the Electronic Visa Approval Letter (e-Val) from the EMGS's website.



What is Electronic Visa Approval Letter (eVAL)?

eVAL is an approval letter issued by the Malaysian Immigration Department in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia to the Malaysian Mission overseas and to the student to inform about the approval of the Student Pass application. Please note that this e-VAL is not the Student Pass, it only grants you permission to enter Malaysia for the further processing of your Student Pass.

Kindly note that students can only be allowed to enroll and register with a valid EVAL at this stage.





STEP 3 | Issuance of Single-Entry Visa (SEV) or eVISA for Student

This <u>Single-Entry Visa (SEV)</u> or <u>eVISA for student</u> is only applicable if you are coming from country that require visa to enter Malaysia. Click <u>here</u> to check SEV required countries. It is a visa for single journey to Malaysia before the student visa is completely issued to you.



Application will need to be done physically and submit your original passport to the nearest Malaysia Embassy or consular office at your country



Application can be done through online without present physically at the Malaysia Embassy or consular office.

STEP 4 | Purchase of Flight Ticket to Malaysia

Upon receiving your SEV or eVISA for Student, you may start looking for the flight ticket to Malaysia. Your entry point must only be **Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA)** or **Kuala Lumpur International Airport 2 (KLIA 2) only.**

Important Notes:

- Only purchase one way flight ticket to Malaysia.
- International students must complete the Malaysia Digital Arrival Card (MDAC) online through the Immigration Department website Malaysia Digital Arrival Card MDAC (imi.gov.my)
- The MDAC can be completed as early as 3 days before arrival; or at the latest upon arrival.



Important Notes:

Individuals **must** present the **following documents** to Immigration Officers at the Malaysia Entry Point upon arrival:

- A valid passport with an appropriate length of validity;
- UM Offer Letter;
- MDAC letter:
- E Visa Approval Letter (eVAL);
- Relevant paperwork i.e. SEV/e-Visa/VOA
 - o For students from **SEV required countries**, please show your Single-Entry Visa (SEV) or eVISA for student and get a "Journey Performed" Stamping
 - o For students from non-SEV required countries, please apply for a Visa On Arrival (VOA).
 - Once the Immigration Officers review the above documents, you will receive a Special Pass /SP Entry Stamping (the example is shown on the following page) with a duration of +/- 30 days (it might vary depending on individual).

What is ISAC?

ISAC is the service centre that operate 24 hours and handles the arrival of all international students before their official entry to Malaysia.

Function of ISAC

- To assist and provide the best welcoming experience for international students arriving at KLIAT1 and T2.
- To **check the record** for international students entering Malaysia and act as the reference point for the Immigration Department of Malaysia (KLIA T1 and T2).
- To **ensure that all necessary documents are sufficient** before submission to Immigration.

Location of ISAC

KLIA T1, Arrival Hall in the main terminal building at Level 3, before the immigration clearance counters.

KLIA T2, Level 3A after the exit from the Skybridge, International Students that arrive in Malaysia on Level 2 will be required to take the passenger lifts to Level 3A.

Who should apply for Visa On Arrival (VOA) unon arrival at the Malaysian Airport?

■ Students who are coming from the non-SEV required countries e.g. UK, Switzerland, etc. will be required to apply for this Visa On Arrival (VOA) and get the stamping as shown on the left.

The pass duration is normally +/- 30 days (it might vary depending on individual)

- Please ensure you receive this SP stamping during the immigration clearance at the airport.
- Please ensure the SP stamping Expiry is not 1 day or less than 7 days expiry.

Why is there an expiry date for the entry stamping (Special Pass/SP)?

- Students will have to complete post arrival medical examination, and submit the original passport along with the visa supporting documents to the UM Visa Counter latest by 10 working days before the pass expired.
- Any late submission, students will have to pay for a penalty of MYR154.00 for the Special Pass/SP Extension.



STEP 6 | Complete Post-Arrival Medical Screening

You must complete a Post-Arrival Medical Screening within 7 days upon your arrival in Malaysia at any **EMGS** registered (panel) clinics. Log on to EMGS Mobile App or Website to access to the list of Panel Clinics.





Important Notes:

- You do not need to make any payment during the post arrival medical screening as the fee has been paid by you during the student visa application through EMGS.
- Additional fee charges will only incurr if the medical screening report is not cleared and require to redo some of the testings for further medical clearance before you are fit for study in Malaysia.
- The university and immigration reserve the right to cancel the offer if your medical report deem unfit for study.
- The Medical Report will be updated through the system directly by the clinic in 3-5 working days and your EMGS status will change to 80%.

Helpful Tips:

- Drink plenty of water the night before your medical screening
- Do not take any pills or medication prior to the screening
- For ladies who are having menstruation or period, it is highly reccommended to do the screening few days (5~7 days) after menstruation (However, it depends on the individual timeline)

You must submit your passport and other supporting documents **latest by 10 working days before** the expiry of the **Special Pass/SP Entry Stamping**. Any late submission, students will have to pay for a penalty of **MYR154.00** (Special Pass/SP Extension – Payable to EMGS) & **MYR50.00** (Visa Processing Fee – Payable to UM).

- Once the post arrival medical screening is completed and the EMGS status changes to 80%, you will need to submit your passport and the following documents to the Visa counter located at the Ground Floor, Examination Building. (Click Here for location)
 - 1) Original Passport
 - 2) A copy of Medical Slip from Qualitas Panel Clinics (EMGS Registered Clinics). Medical examination must be done at the EMGS's registered clinics. Please refer to the EMGS's website for the Qualitas Panel clinic list (Click here)
 - 3) UM Offer Letter and a Visa Clearance Letter issued by your respective Faculty.
 - 4) 1 piece of Passport-size Photo (White Background only)
 - 5) A copy of Passport (Details page), EMGS Approval Letter & Visa Approval Letter (eVAL)
 - 6) A copy of eVISA for Student (For students who obtained the eVISA for Student prior entering Malaysia)
 - 7) A copy of Visa On Arrival (VOA) (For students who obtained the VOA at the airport)
- The sticker endorsement process for your Student Pass will take at least 21 30 working days from the date it is submitted to EMGS. Students are not allowed to arrange / book their travel whilst the passport is being processed for sticker endorsement.

Disclaimer: The above is a rough estimation on the timeline for post arrival visa processing. There might possibility of delay depending on the day-to-day operation and regulation from Malaysian Immigration Department. Special Pass Extension Penalty of **MYR154** will be charged if the passport is submitted with less than 10 working days of the entry visa validity.



After submission of your Passport to Visa Unit, you may check the progress status of your Student Pass Sticker Endorsement processing through EMGS's Website or EMGS Mobile App.

You may visit the Visa counter to collect your passport once the **Status reaches 100% and your name** has been updated on the MASD <u>website</u> (masd.um.edu.my). Information on iKAD & Insurance is normally issued within 21 – 30 working days after the Student Pass endorsement.







- 1. When to collect back your passport from the UM Visa counter after EMGS Status reaches 100%?
 - Students are only allowed to visit Visa Counter to collect the passport once notification has been updated on MASD website.
- 2. What should I bring during passport collection?
 - Students are required to bring the Acknowledgement Slip For Student (Pink Paper) during the passport collection.
- 3. Can my friend collect the passport on behalf of me?

It is strictly not allowed to collect the passport on behalf. The passport holder must present during the collection.

 A student pass is a multiple entry visa which gives you permission to remain in Malaysia for the purposes of study at an approved institution on an approved course. 	 A valid i-Kad is the only substitute identification document for foreign nationals recognised by the Department of Immigration in Peninsular Malaysia and MUST BE KEPT WITH YOU AT ALL TIMES. With an i-Kad, your passport can now be kept away at a secure place. However, i-Kad is not a replacement document for international travel or travel in East Malaysia (Sabah and Sarawak). 	 This is the medical insurance card that you have purchased along during the student visa application on EMGS Portal. You may check the insurance that you purchased by looking through My Application on your EMGS account.
